


## **Steps to Success:**






3. Review the **Assessment of Learning** document for general information about this assessment, as well as specific information regarding **Performance Tasks**.




4. Click on the back arrow to return to the Table of Contents.




5. Click on **Professional Learning Videos** in the Table of Contents.




#### 6. Click on All Videos.




7. Scroll down to the **Assessment** section. Click on **Performance Tasks** to view the video and gain valuable information regarding this assessment.




8. Click on your Experience Math program to return to your dashboard.




### 9. Click on your desired Topic.




## 10. Click on **End of Topic Resources**.




11. Scroll down to the **Assessment of Learning** section to find the **Performance Task**.




12. Click on the 3 dots to view possible actions.




13. Click on **Performance Task** to view the assessment.
