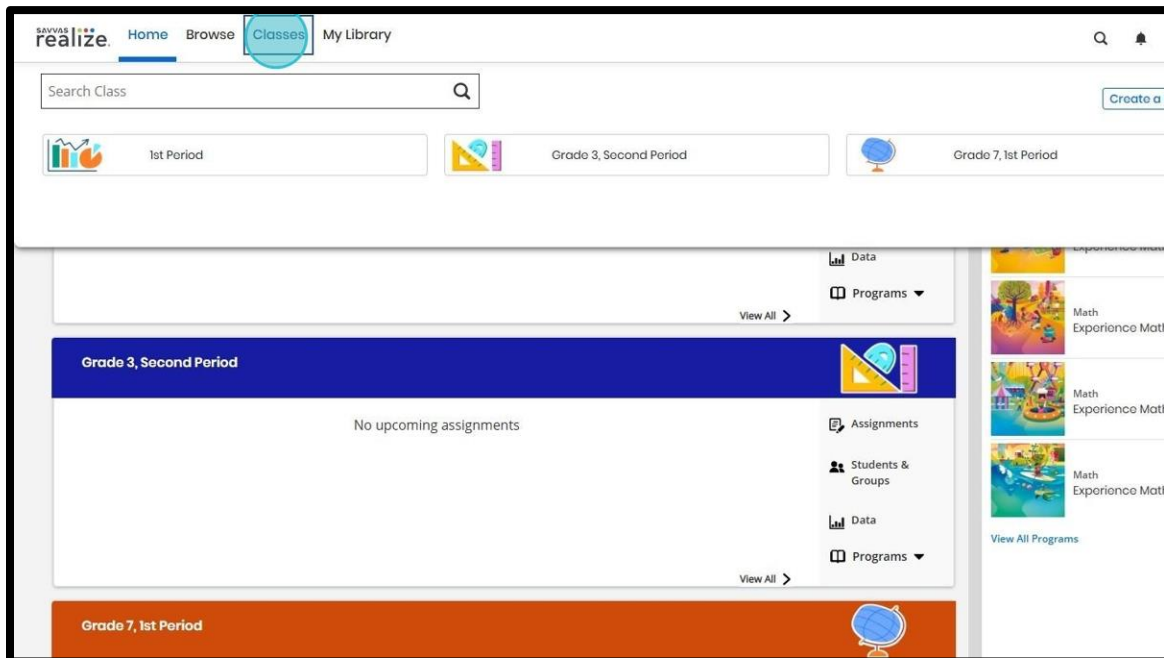


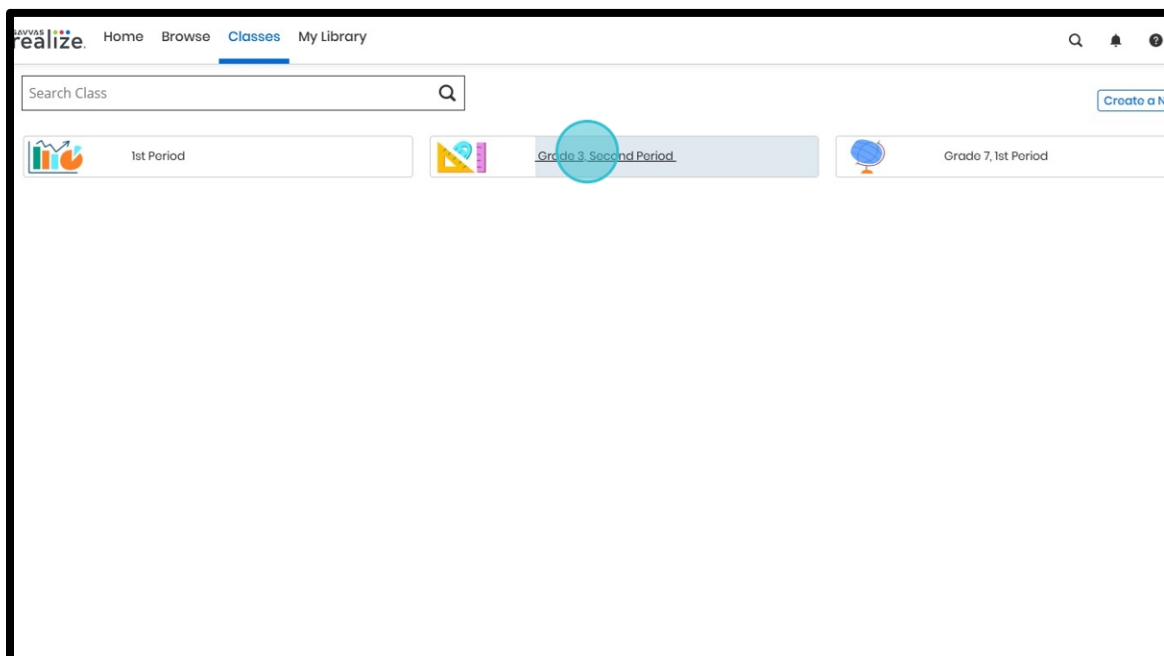
Realize Data at the Assessment Level

Steps to Success:

1. Navigate to your **Experience Math** dashboard. Click on **Classes**.



2. Select your desired **Class**.



3. Select your desired **Assessment** to view available data.

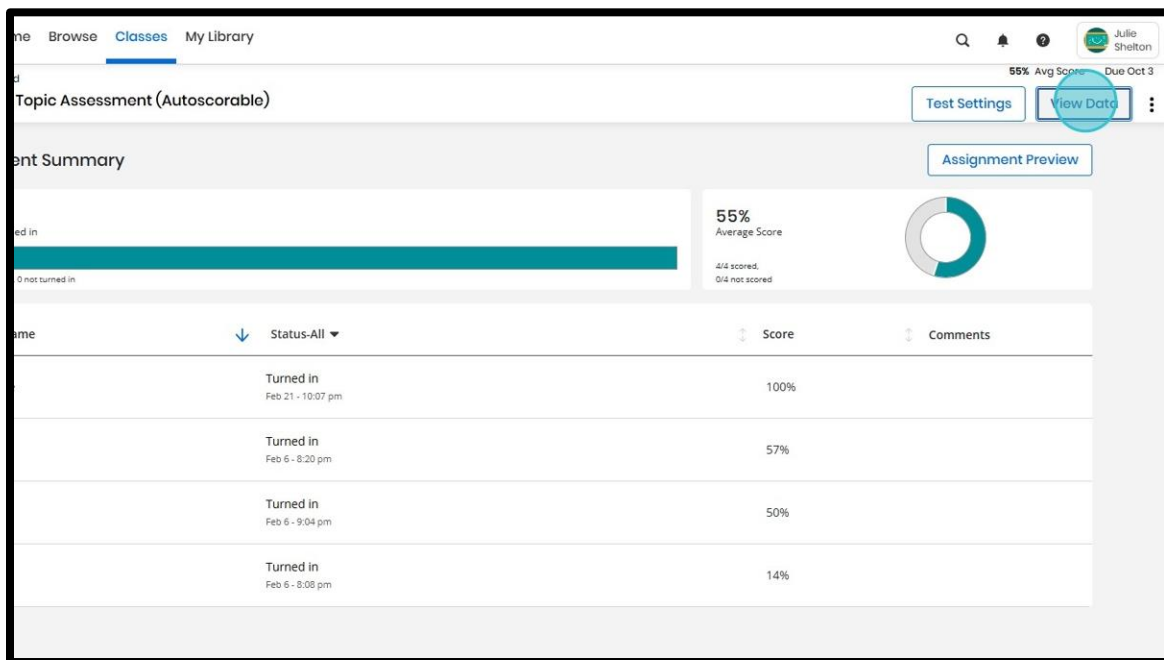

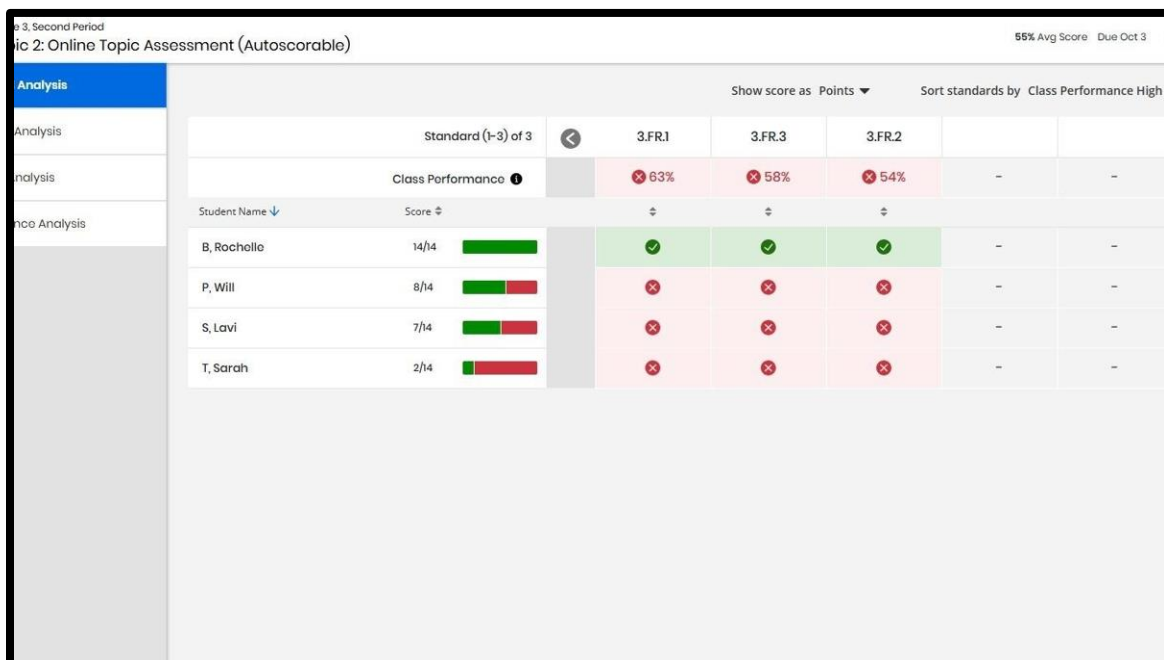


5. Click on **View Data** to view more detailed assessment data.

7. Select **Question Analysis** to examine performance for each question of the Assessment.





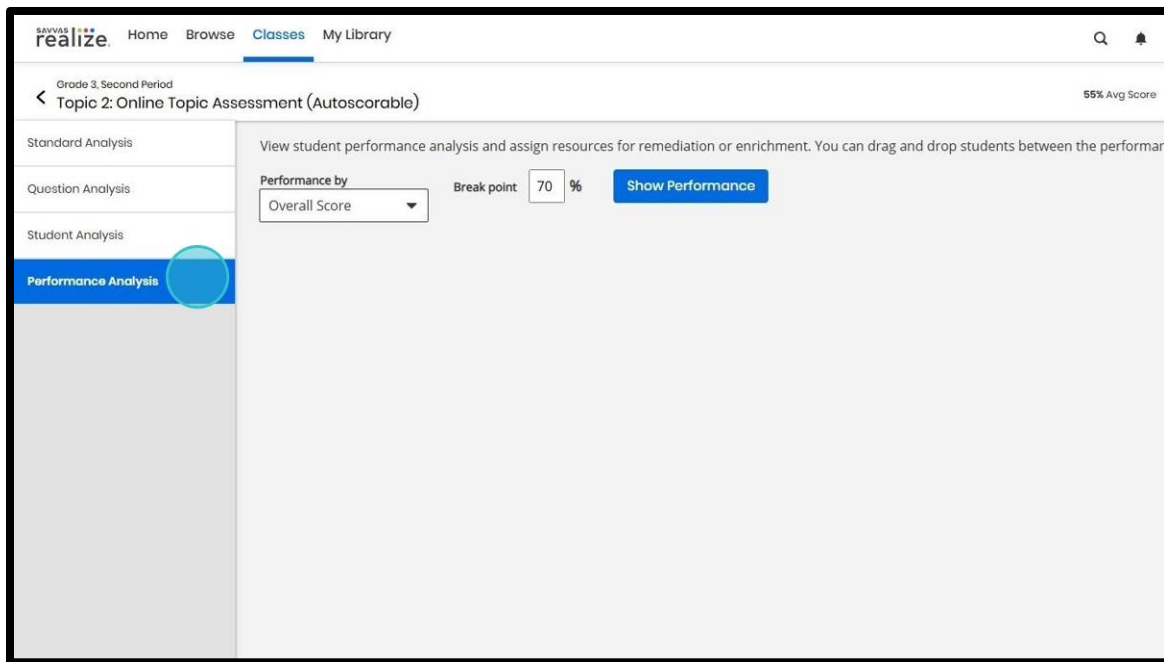

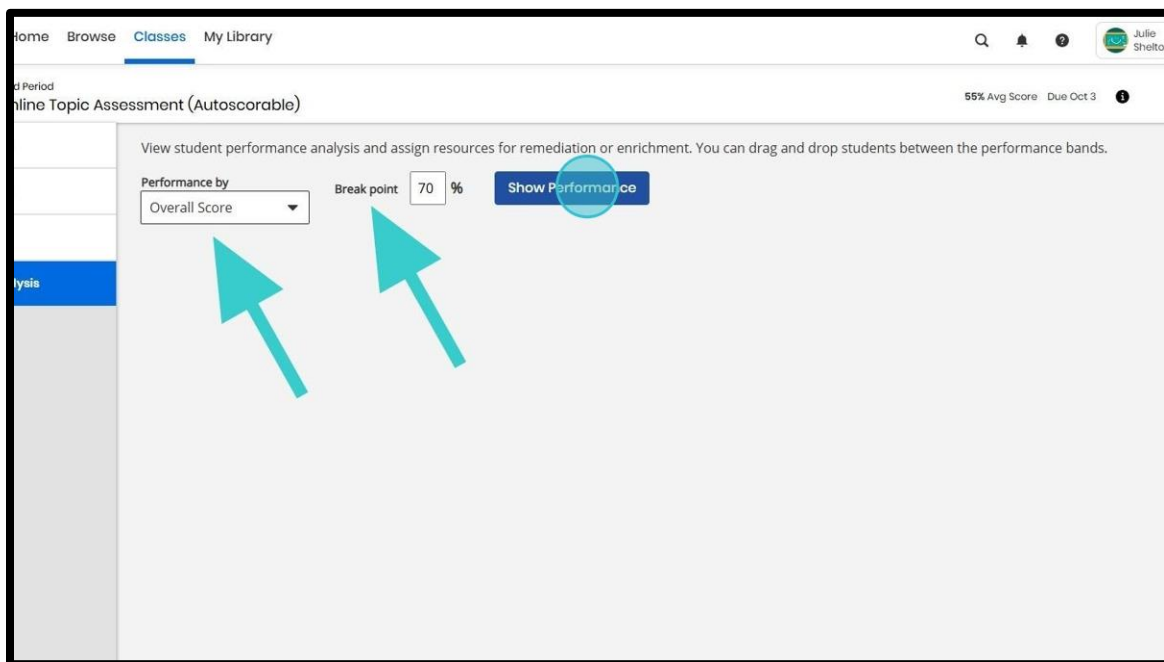

10. Adjust the parameters for **Performance By** and **Break Point** for your analysis. Click on **Show Performance** to view the results.



11. The Analysis will sort students into categories of performance **less than** and **more than** the **Break Point**.
